# SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 118th annual reunion of the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held Saturday May 26th, 2001 at the Shamokin Area High School. The cafeteria was the setting for the dinner and the afterglow, and the auditorium was the setting for the entertainment and business meeting. Participating in the festivities were 305 alumni members and guests. Anniversary pennants flew high. Educational and General Century Club books were on display naming contributions giving \$100 or more from years past. Current contributors' names will be placed in the books.

Alumni president Joan (Fauland) Eltringham '59 opened the evening by welcoming everyone to the reunion. Attorney Myron Moskowicz '42 gave the invocation. "God Bless America" was lead by Joan (Fauland) Eltringham '59 with Irvin Liachowitz '42 accompanying on the piano. Country House Restaurant served a catered dinner. Following dinner, members and guests adjourned to the auditorium.

Alumni president Joan (Fauland) Eltringham '59 opened the business meeting with a correction to the necrology. Class of 1964 Edward T. Kashela is alive. She then requested the Alumni to take a few moments for silent prayer in memory of our deceased members. Since the secretary's and treasurers' reports were in the newsletter, on a motion by John Klinger '68 and a second by Mary Kay Cook '68, the secretary's report and treasurer's report were not read aloud and accepted as written in the newsletter.

The class of 2001 was presented and welcomed into the association. Thirty-two members were present. Thirty-five seniors completed the scholarship test. Class president Laura Schrader presented the Association with their class pennant. Alumni president Joan (Fauland) Eltringham '59 recognized and thanked the Class of 2001 advisors Edward Bailey and Wayne Brokenshire and Senior Coordinator Anita Shaeffer for the time and support.

Entertainment selections from Shamokin Area Jr/Sr High School musical "Wind in the Willows" were introduced by and accompanied on the piano by Bonnie Ensinger Klinger '68. William Wagner '01, Mike Stadnicki, and Kelly Deklinski sang, "That's what friends are for" and "The Day you came into My Life." Following the entertainment, Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 and Susan Kropinski '75 were assisted by members of the senior class for

the distribution of the door prizes. Fifteen lucky members or guests went home with a special memorabilia of the evening.

Alumni Vice-President Robert Ensinger '74 introduced the anniversary classes and any other class wishing to make a presentation or announcement. These included:

- Class of 1931: Kim Mulliner and Midred (Bixler) Sharp, class representatives. At this time the class of '31 accounts are closed. The members of the class stood and were recognized.

- Class of 1936: Kimber Savidge gave a report of attendance. One hundred eighty-eight graduated in 1936; seventy-two are still living and twenty-one live in Shamokin. Fifteen members donated \$100 to the Century Club for a total of \$1500. In addition, \$2113 was collected for a total donation of \$3613.

- Class of 1941: 'Beans' Weaver asked his class to rise and be recognized. On behalf of the class, a check for \$3415 was donated in addition to \$300 for a total of \$3715.

- Silver Anniversary Class - Class of 1976 - Kathy (Weaver) Rebar reminded the Alumni her Class was known as the Bicentennial Class and was the first to graduate from this building. She thanked the Association for allowing their class to advertise on the web site and in the news bulletin of their upcoming reunion on July 7 at the Indians Valley Country Club. She encouraged all members to visit the web site. Kathy presented the Association with a donation of \$185 and congratulated the Class of 2001 and wished them the best of luck.

- Golden Anniversary Class - Class of 1951 - Nancy (Updegrove) Price and Shirley (Fisher) Jackson were pleased to announce that their class had a goal of \$5100. However, they exceeded their goal and were proud to donate \$7600 to the Association on behalf of their class.

Robert Ensinger '74 searched out for the winner of the Distance Award. After a few lessons in geography, he named Donald Bixler '43 from Huntington Beach, California was the recipient. The Golden Anniversary Class was presented with gifts from the association. Irvin Liachowitz '42, member of the Educational Trust Fund Committee, introduced this year's scholarship winners. Coal Township (CT) Alumni Association gave 4 scholarship awards. A total of 16 awards were presented ranging from \$500 to \$2500. The awards annual total was \$19500. Over a period of four years, the scholarships total \$78,000. These awards are

9th award - \$1100 (CT) - Joe Knapick will attend Lock Haven University to study Engineering

8th award - \$1300 - Justin Yancheski will attend ITT to study Computer Science

7th award - \$1400 - Tona Faust will attend Lebanon Valley College to study Music Business

6th award - \$1600 - Jon Hopta will attend Penn State University to study Accounting and International Business

5th award - \$1800 - Ben Herman will attend Drexel University to study Biomedical Engineering

4th award - \$1900 (CT) - Vince Poplaski will attend Cornell University to study Economics

3rd award - \$2000 (CT) - Ron Manney will attend Lafayette to study Civil Engineering

2nd award - \$2200 - Chris Karnes will attend Juniata College to study Zoology

1st award - \$2500 (CT) - Karen Cook will attend CedarCrest to study Political Science and Communications Eugene Boughner '60 high school principal addressed the alumni and spoke of the many accomplishments of the Shamokin Area School District. He welcomed the Alumni and guests and informed the Class of 2001 that our Alumni Association is the oldest active association in the United States. He listed many highlights of the past school year. This year's musical was "Wind in the Willows". District Orchestra, Regional Band, Community Concerts, and Bloodmobile were held at the high school. Our 8th graders received an award for the school of \$77,499 for their accomplishment on the State Assessment Test. The National Honor Societies participate

in many projects. The Basketball team won the Schuylkill League and District IV titles. Our School Newspaper is back. The PTA is very active and one of their provisions is the reading program RIF. The Prayer Club meets every Wednesday morning. SADD is very active. Patriotic programs to honor veterans are held annually. Graduation projects are required for graduation. Baccalaureate services have been restored to our graduating ceremonies. New courses have been added to our curriculum: Mass Media II-newspaper, TV Studio; Latin I, II by television with Mt. Carmel Area; Honors Science 8; Jr High Computer Applications; Advanced Computers for Jr High; Web Design/Adobe Photoshop, C++; AP English, German/Spanish for Jr High, and Music Literature. In answer to the question, "Are our students getting into colleges?", he listed a wide span of accredited schools of which the Class of 2001 will attend in the fall. Irvin Liachowitz '42 presented the 2001-2002 slate of officers for ratification:

A move and second was heard to elect the nominees. Vote was taken. Slate was elected.

Treasurer, William Korbich '54 informed the Association 305 were in attendance and pointed out Class of '51: 33 attended; Class of '41: 29 attended. 32 out of the 35 seniors attended with 26 parents. William Korbich '54 presented the 2001-2002 slate of Education Fund Committee members for ratification: Myron Moskowicz, '42; Tom Olcese '48, and Ron Chamberlain '59. On a motion by Stacey (Gubernot) Erdman '65 and second by Helen Jane Murphy '43 the slate was accepted for vote. Through vote of those present slate was ratified. Joan (Fauland) Eltringham '59 introduced the new President, Robert Ensinger '74 and Vice President, Joan (Rhoades) Donmoyer '52. President, Robert Ensinger '74 concluded the business meeting. He addressed the Class of 2001 and asked them not to forget us. The meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater (Irvin Liachowitz accompanist). Myron Moskowicz '42 gave the benediction. Members and guests were invited to return to the commons area for the afterglow.

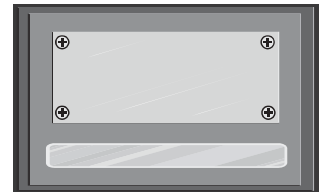

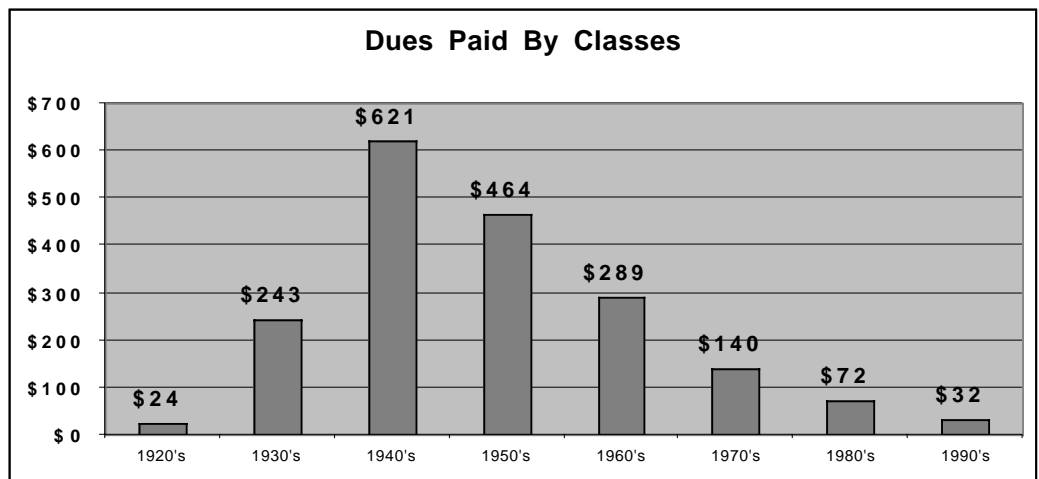
