SECRETARY'S REPORT

Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association was held Saturday, May 25th, 2002 at the Shamokin Area High School. The cafeteria was the setting for the dinner and afterglow, and the auditorium was the setting for the entertainment and business meeting. Participating in the festivities were 312 alumni members and guests. Anniversary pennants flew high. Educational and General Century Club books were on display naming contributions of \$100 or more from years past. Current contributors, names will be placed in the books. Alumni president Robert Ensinger '74 opened the evening by welcoming everyone to the reunion. Lavis Caterer served dinner. Following dinner, members and guests moved to the auditorium. The business meeting opened with a few moments of silent prayer in recognition of the deceased members of the association. The secretary's and treasurer's reports were in the Newsletter. On a motion by alumni member and a second by Bruce Clutcher '72, the secretary's report was accepted as printed. On a motion of John Milbrand and second by Glenn Henninger '47 the treasurer's report was accepted as printed.

The class of 2002 was presented and welcomed into the association. Class president Gene Welsh and Secretary Daniel Venn presented their pennant to the Alumni Association. Gene thanked the Alumni for the Banquet and opportunity to receive scholarships. Shamokin Area High School's Quarter Tones entertained the Alumni and guests. The four members are Mike Stadnicki '02, Chris Manning '02, Chris Walters '02, and Joe Hardin. Mike will attend IUP and pursue a degree in Music Education. Chris Manning will attend LVC for a degree in Physics, and Chris Walters will attend PSU for a degree in Music.

Seniors assisting Mary Anne Pitorak Miller '74 of the program committee handed out door prizes to those holding winning tickets. There were thirty-six winners this evening.

Alumni Vice-President Joan Rhoades Donmoyer '52 recognized the anniversary classes and any other class wishing to make a presentation or announcement.

The 119th annual reunion of the 1932 - In honor of celebrating their Shamokin Area High School 70th reunion donated \$190.

1942 - Bill Wagner represented his class. A donation of \$4242.42 was given to the Association in honor of their 60th reunion.

1962 - Representing the 40th reunion class, Claire Clutcher Varney presented the Association with a donation of \$230 from the class and \$200 from Joseph Fidler '62.

1972 - In honor of his 30th class reunion, Bruce Clutcher donated \$100.

1982 - Class was recognized and asked to stand.

1947 - Class was recognized and asked to stand.

1992 - Class was recognized and asked to stand.

1977 - Silver Anniversary: Class was recognized and asked to stand. 1952 - Golden Anniversary: Joan Milbrand Kelley asked her class to stand and be recognized. The Class of '52 donated \$3200 to the Century Club and \$1952 to the General Fund for a total of \$5652. In addition to tonight's generosity, the class wanted to donate something to their old High School building - now the Arts Center. A piano was much needed, and the class of '52 came through.

At this time, the presentation of gifts to the Golden Anniversary Class from the SAHS Alumni Association.

On a motion by Bill Korbich and accepted by all, two distance awards will be presented. Nancy Renn Drew '52 and Arthur Shipe '37 traveled from the state of Washington to be here tonight.

Irvin Liachowitz '42 member of the Educational Trust Fund Committee, introduced the scholarship winners. Coal Township Alumni Association gave 4 scholarship awards. These were the 9th, 4th, 3rd and 1st awards. A total of 12 awards were presented ranging from \$500 to \$2,500. The awards totaled \$17,100. 2nd award - \$2,100 Kelly Deklinski; Indiana Univ. of PA; Music Education

1st award - \$2,500 Robert Yucha; Drexel Univ.; Bio-Medical Engineering

Eugene Boughner'60, high school principal, addressed the alumni and spoke of the many accomplishments of the students. He listed a wide span of accredited schools of which the Class of 2002 will attend in the fall. The popular school of choice was Penn College to pursue a degree in Computer Systems and Networking. New courses this past year were AP Physics, AP English, and C++. Next year, Sustained Silent Reading will be incorporated into our daily schedule and remedial courses will be offered to students scoring below proficient on the PSSA test. Project Pearl Program has provided our Junior High students with Career Day, Job Shadowing, and tutoring after school. Our District has received an award of \$90,000 from the state for increased attendance rates. Some of the highlights of the past school year included musical "Bye, Bye Birdie", Regional/State Band, Orchestra, Choral, and District Jazz Festival. Our Band won first place at the White Marlin Festival. He commended the newly formed INDIAN PRIDE club encouraging school spirit. Our students scored high in the PA Math League Contest. The Red Cross commended our students on their politeness and attentiveness. Sixty-eight students donated blood with sixty being a first timer. This past week a Veteran's Memorial Service was held and six diplomas were given to Veterans who were unable to complete High School because of military duties during WWII. In conclusion, Mr. Boughner said we should thank the parents for being positive influences and asked the parents to thank their sons/daughters for succeeding.

William Korbich announced to the Alumni extra copies of the News-Item Weekender are in the rear of the auditorium. He thanked the News-Item for these complimentary copies.



By the fortieth year, it was abundantly clear, we were definitely over the hill. Those who weren't dead had to crawl out of bed, and be home in time for their pill.


