SECRETARY'S REPORT

Minutes - May 28, 2005
Meeting/Banquet

The Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association's 122nd reunion was held May 28th with President Shirley (Fisher) Jackson welcoming everyone to the festivities. The invocation was given by Rev. Robert S. Commerford followed by the pledge to the flag and singing of "God Bless America" lead by Rob Ensinger with Irvin Liachowitz as pianist.

The assembly of graduates and guests applauded Masser's Catering, in their first year of catering, for the excellent meal that was served. Books from the 25th, 50th, 75th and 100th anniversaries were on display along with books containing names of contributors over the years to the general and educational century clubs. It was noted Garth Hall has forms available for mailing to order wooden miniature replicas of Shamokin High School dedicated in 1914, Coal Township High School completed in 1927 and the Victoria - Majestic Theatres which give history of each. An insert on old, old Alumni Association dates, poetry and article written by the Historian from the 25th reunion was included with the evening's program flyer.

Adjourning to the auditorium, the business meeting commenced with a few moments of silent prayer for deceased class members. Bonnie Klinger, director of the high school musical "Plain and Fancy" provided piano accompaniment for the entertainment. "Young and Foolish" sung by Kurt Troxell and "Take Your Time Take

Your Pick" sung by Caleb Arnold, Ashley Hubler and Meredith Szymanski.

The class of 2005 presented their pennant and class was recognized as were class advisers Shannon (Klinger) Anderson and Ed Bailey.

Mary Anne (Pitorak) Miller, program committee representative, assisted by Susan Kropinski and members of class 2005, presented 25 door prizes to winning ticket holders.

Vice President John Klinger recognized the anniversary classes. Klinger remarked on our association being the oldest and most active in the United States. Awards exceeded \$750,000 last year given by Coal Township and Shamokin. Classes presenting gifts were:

Class of 1935 - \$250 to the general fund and \$300 to the educational fund.

Class of 1940 - \$1,565 to the general fund and \$1,565 to the H. Richard Hilbush Scholarship Fund. Hilbush was a member of the class of 1940.

Class of 1945 - \$2,005 to the educational fund presented by James Blessing, class representative.

Class of 1965 - \$950 to the educational fund presented by Robert Kramer. Kramer reminded everyone that the class of 1965 was the largest to graduate and the last class under the maroon and gray colors.

Golden anniversary class of 1955 - \$19,550 to the educational fund presented by Nancy (Schrawder) Booth and James Howerter, class representatives.

The class of 1980 will hold a reunion this summer as reported by Brenda (Piechowski) Messner class representative. The class of 1970 will also be meeting later (June 25th) at the Sunbury Social Club as reported by Dennis Miller.

A coal pen paperweight with attached plaque of a 1915 photo of the Shamokin High School was the gift presented to the golden anniversary class members in attendance. Class was recognized.

Two alumni traveled from Northern and Southern California and due to the close proximity Donald Bixler (1943) and James Williams (1955) were each given the distance award.

Irvin Liachowitz of the education trust committee announced the winners of the alumni scholarship testing. The scholarships are for each of four years of college. Fourteen awards were given ranging from \$600 to \$2500 from Coal Township and Shamokin Alumni Associations. Coal Township gave the 8th, 7th, 6th, 5th, 4th, 2nd and 1st awards, Shamokin gave the 14th, 13th, 12th, 11th, 10th, 9th, and 3rd awards. Awards for these participants total \$24,800 or \$99,200 over a 4 year period.

Chris Venna, High School Principal, rounding out his first year, announced accomplishments in academics, athletics, music and arts, and service. Four students qualified for the 700 club for the SAT tests. Students taking college courses at Luzerne County Community College to satisfy graduation requirements and also earn college credits prior to graduating from high school. Envirothon Team qualified for the state competition by placing first in the count competition. Football, boys and girls soccer and basketball all qualified for district playoffs. Track and Field qualified several students for the state competition at Shippensburg University. Individually, one wrestler

notched his 100th career victory and several school records were broken in swimming. Excellent concerts and programs with a musical "Plain and Fancy" that was produced this year being the first time since 1967. Students qualified for district, regional and state festivals in band, chorus, and orchestra. 1st ever Senior Scholastic Art Exhibit held at the Career Arts Center. Volunteer work for Salvation Army, Special Olympics, and canned food drive for Manna for the Many and Penny Drive for member of the senior class in need of a liver transplant, Doug Dobson raising over \$2500 in pennies over a 5 day period. Venna stated the school is

re-evaluating curriculum, aligning to state standards and maintaining the building and grounds of the campus. Venna announced Baccalaureate Service, Senior Scholastic Awards Program, and Commencement exercises dates.

James Booth, president of the education fund committee presented for ratification new trustees Susan Kropinski and Frances (Lee) Brennan appointed for a five year term with Frederick Reed renewing a 5 year term. Slate was accepted on motion of Dennis Miller and a 2nd given by Tom Olcese. Serving in their 5 year term for one year, as officers, are Tom Olcese vice president, William Korbich

treasurer, and Joan Fauland Eltringham secretary. There are 15 trustees each serving rotating 5 year terms.

Susan Kropinski, nominating committee presented the slate of Alumni officers for next year. John Klinger president, Mary Anne (Pitorak) Miller vice president, William Korbich treasurer, Karen (Wilk) Colangelo secretary, Jeffrey Clutcher, registrar and Helen Jane Murphy historian and asked for any nominations from the floor. On motion of Dorothy (Zebrowski) Goodman the nominations were closed with a second by Helen Jane Murphy. A motion to accept the slate of officers was made by Tom Olcese and a second given by Dennis Miller.

After the business meeting concluded with the singing of the Alma Mater and benediction from Rev. Commerford, everyone was invited back to the school's commons area where the Afterglow was held dancing to the music of Vic Boris Sound Expression. A buffet was also served. Musical chairs and dance contests were held.

GENERAL FUND FINANCIAL SITUATION

In order for an organization to remain strong it needs the support of its members. In the case of an alumni association, the members who have remained in the immediate area of the association are available to physically support the association. Those that have moved from the area do not have that opportunity.

However, both those in the immediate area and those who have moved have the opportunity, (and more so the responsibility) to support the association financially.

Your executive committee wants each member to have the opportunity to read news about your alumni association. Each year over 11,000 newsletters are mailed to alumni members. We realize that many of them are discarded without being looked at (yet alone read). In order for this information to be received, it just be printed and mailed. The cost for this averages about \$1.00 per member.

The amount of money received for the general fund \$10,966 was donated by 306 members of the association. This is very commendable. However, this is only 2.8% of the total membership. There are additional general expenses throughout the year as well as expenses for the banquet. This year the General Fund contributions were \$4,617 less than the average for the past 5 or 6 years. The Dues contributions were down \$175. If you look at the financial report you will notice that the ending balance for 2006 is \$4,968 less than the 2005 ending balance. This is very close to the amount of the difference in contributions from past years. We were generally carrying a \$12,000 balance each year. If the missing 97.2% of the membership would just send in their annual dues of \$2.00 or a small donation of \$1.00 to the general fund we would remain financially solvent.

If this trend of less dues and contributions continues, another deficit contribution of \$4,617 will bring the balance down to about \$3,000.

Some of you graduated from Shamokin High School, others from Shamokin Joint High School and more recently Shamokin Area High School. It really does not matter what the name of the school was when you graduated, you should have some fond memories that would move you to make an effort to keep the Shamokin Area High School Alumni Association solvent.
